

Cell Phone Procedure at Lakeland

Cell phone calls or messaging are not permitted from 7:30 AM to 2:35 PM.

Electronic devices (including headphones, earbuds or chargers) should not be seen, heard or used at any time between 7:30 AM and 2:35 PM, unless it is a student's lunch or a study hall for the purposes of listening to music or playing games. Teachers always retain the right to allow students to use their electronic devices for instructional purposes in the classroom.

Video taping, picture taking, or audio recording with any electronic device is strictly prohibited.

Listening to music or playing games on an electronic device is permitted during a student's lunch or study hall with headphones.

Cell phone use is NOT permitted at any other place or time in the building during the school day.

If a student needs to call or message his/her parent / guardian, he/she must come to the Main Office.

Students are not permitted to use cell phones during school emergencies such as evacuation or lockdown of the school building.

Consequences:

- Cell phone or electronic device may be confiscated by a teacher or administration. The parent / guardian will be notified and asked to retrieve it from the Main Office.

Note: Any student who refuses to give up his/her cell phone or electronic device for confiscation will receive an automatic 4-hour Saturday detention and 9 discipline points.
